



ENHANCED COVID-19 SCREENING & ISOLATION PROTOCOLS

Mandatory Self-Screening of Students & Staff

>> Students and staff need to check for symptoms of illness **every day before going to school**. You can screen your child or yourself by taking the [COVID-19 school and childcare screening](#)

Enhanced On-site Screening

>> Schools will conduct daily on-site confirmation of self-screening for secondary students, staff, and visitors – either before entering the school, or at the start of the school day.

Secondary Students, Teachers & Staff

- All secondary students must confirm their COVID-19 self-screening result daily.
- All school staff (elementary & secondary) must confirm their COVID-19 self-screening result daily.

New Isolation Requirements

>> Staff, students, and children attending childcare with any new or worsening symptom of COVID-19, as indicated in the school and childcare screening tool - **even those with only one symptom** - must stay home until:

- They receive a negative COVID-19 test result
- They receive an alternative diagnosis by a health care professional, or
- It has been 10 days since their symptom onset, and they are feeling better.

>> All **asymptomatic** household contacts of symptomatic individuals are required to quarantine until the symptomatic household member:

- receives a negative COVID-19 test result, or
- receives an alternative diagnosis by a health care professional

>> If the symptomatic individual **tests positive -- or is not tested -- and does not receive an alternative diagnosis** from a health care professional, the symptomatic individual must isolate (including from household members) for **10 days** from symptom onset, and all household contacts must isolate until **14 days** from their last contact with the symptomatic individual.
