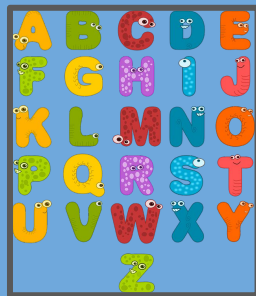

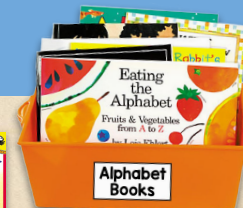

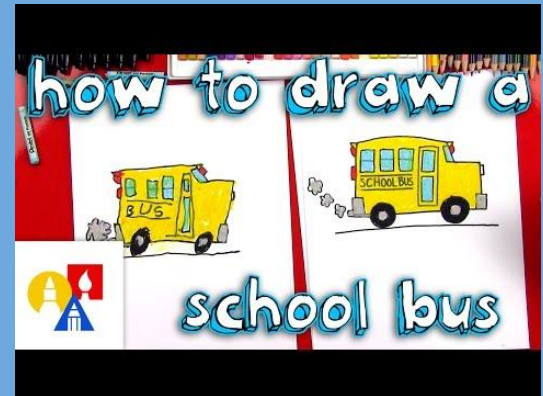
ABC's of Kindergarten

Click on the link and draw the picture.



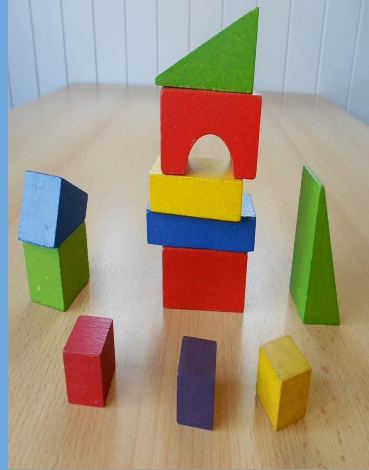
ABC's of Kindergarten

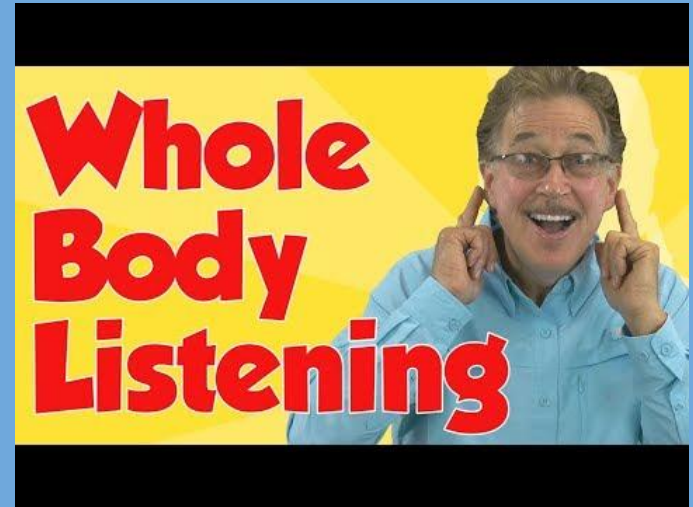
L- Listener

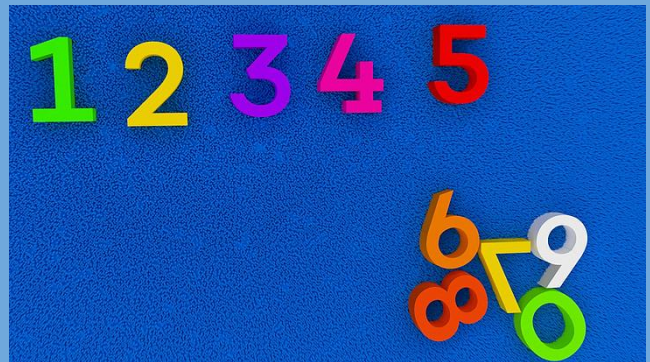
ABC's of Kindergarten

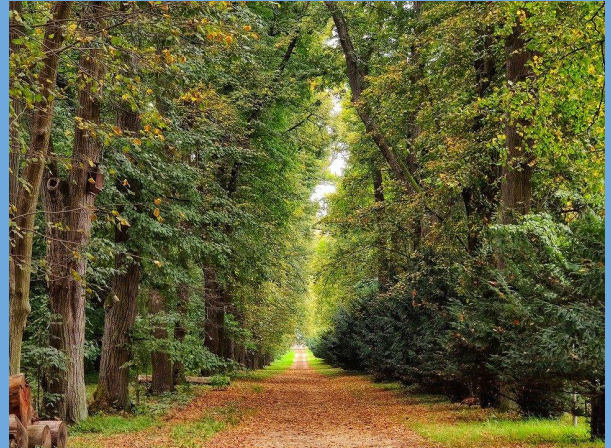
O- Observer

Think of any questions you might have for your teachers. Ask mom or dad to write them down and bring them on the first day of school.



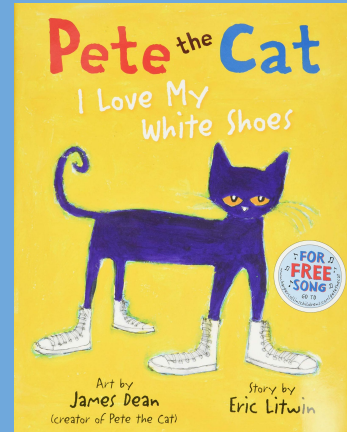
ABC's of Kindergarten

S- Scientist

In Kindergarten, we explore different topics in science and social studies. We look at different experiments and make predictions about we think might happen!

Challenge:

Try the Celery Experiment. You will need three glasses of water (half way),

Three pieces of celery and food colouring. Put the food colouring into the glasses of water and then place one piece of celery in each jar. Wait for a few days. Draw what you think will happen to the celery.

Challenge:

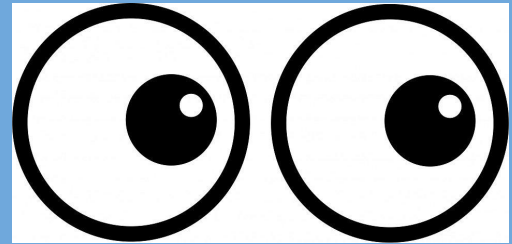
Draw a picture of something you like about yourself (e.g. hair or eyes)

Try to get your eyes checked before coming to Kindergarten :)

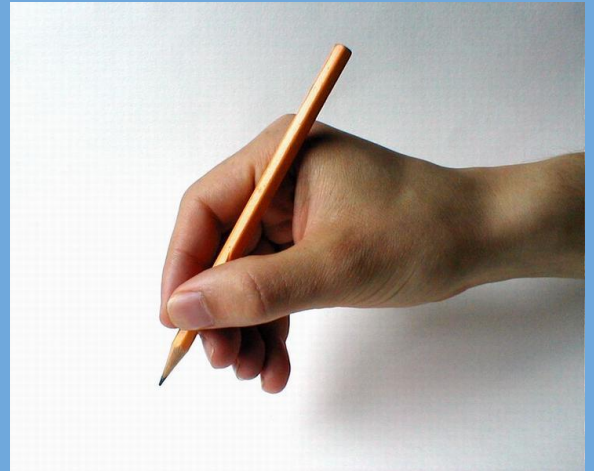
ABC's of Kindergarten

Practice zipping up your coat!



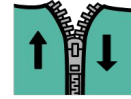
GETTING DRESSED/UNDRESS SUMMER CHALLENGE!

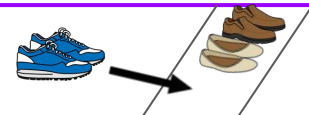

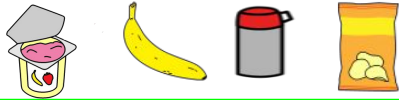
LUNCH & SNACK TIME SUMMERTIME CHALLENGE
